

Covenant Children's Ministries' (CCM) mission is "...to show the love and hope of Jesus Christ by supporting tangible services that meet the needs of the underserved children, young adults, and their families." On behalf of the Board of Directors of CCM, we are pleased and grateful that you are considering applying for funds through its Mission and Ministry Grant Program (MMGP).

We celebrate that, since 2012, CCM has awarded almost \$2,000,000 in grants to applicants from Covenant churches and related organizations with a commitment to meet the needs of underserved children, young adults, and their families.

In 2021, CCM marked its 100th anniversary and, as you can imagine, over that century, the ministry has had to adapt, morph, and change to cultural shifts, unforeseen obstacles, and new opportunities as they presented themselves. Though the commitment to this mission remains steadfast, like in years past, the expression of that mission is changing.

After a year and a half of prayerful discernment by the CCM Board of Directors, and against the backdrop of the significant cultural and global events of the past two years, two decisions were reached. First, that the campus in Princeton, IL is to be sold, and the proceeds invested in support of future ministry. Second, as was announced around this time a year ago, that the Mission and Ministry Grant program be re-envisioned to meet the new and emerging needs and opportunities presented by a post-pandemic world.

Practically this means that <u>2022 will be the final cycle of applications and disbursements of this</u> program in its current form. **Applications for this final cycle will be due by 5:00pm (Central) on Friday, March 18, 2022**, in order to be considered for grant awards. Information will be made available at <u>www.covcare.org/ccm-grants/</u>.

CCM continues to stand at a place of hope, where it honors past ministries, and embraces the excitement of a new future direction. Most importantly however, CCM continues the work of improving and protecting the lives of vulnerable children and youth in Christ's name, seeking to "...do for the least of these..." (Matthew 25).

In order to be eligible for funding, your program must be a part of the Evangelical Covenant Church (ECC) or in active and acknowledged partnership with, an entity within the ECC.

Because MMG funds are limited and not intended to be an ongoing source of funding, priority consideration will be given to first time applicants.

All applications must include a letter of acknowledgement and support from the Superintendent of the Conference where the program takes place.
